Graduate School Admission Requirements

Minimum requirements for acceptance to the Graduate School for the MLA Non-Baccalaureate Program are:

- Cumulative grade point average of courses taken at K-State of 3.0;
- 2.5 for probationary admission - all applicants are reviewed on a case by case basis.

Any thing less than a 2.5 GPA will require the submittal of:

- A letter of intent expressing why the student is interested in becoming a landscape architect
- A portfolio of work accomplished in the first five semesters at K-State

Graduate courses, shown in bold lettering on the curriculum guide, begin during the summer, after the sixth semester (3rd year). Successful completion of the sixth semester and acceptance into the MLA program by the Graduate School begin the MLA program of study for non-baccalaureate students.
